

We use **prepositions** to show the connection between nouns and adjectives in a sentence. Common prepositions are on, in, at, from.

At: specific locations, addresses, shops, events I'm **at** Wei's house. Ellie isn't **at** the party.

On: single mountains, planets, beaches, islands, public transport

I get to school **on** the bus. I'm **on** Mount Everest.

In: buildings, cities, countries, continents, groups of people

I couldn't see Anna in the crowd. Do you live in Italy?






